To all Policyholders,

Your Board of Directors takes pleasure in presenting the 160th Annual Report for the year ending December 31, 2021.

In 2021, the COVID-19 outbreak continued and our office continued to be closed to ensure the safety of our staff, policy holders and business partners. Technology allowed people to connect anytime, anywhere, to anyone near or far. We continued to work to serve all your insurance needs. Our agents and brokers were just a phone call or email away from responding to your policy enquiries and claims needs. That has not changed, we continue to be here for you!

Over the past year, our Gross Premiums Written grew modestly to \$18 million, which is 5.8% over 2020. Claims frequency was up slightly at 3.1%, however claims severity increased by 63.7%. Claims are getting larger.
